## REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS

### NOTICE TO ENGINEERING FIRMS

The Veazie Sewer District is currently considering engineering firms to accommodate future wastewater system and collection design needs over the next three year period.

The aerated lagoon system began serving the Veazie community in August of 1989. The unique features of the facility included ease of operation, low energy consumption, flexibility in operation, future expansion capability, and use of onsite soils for lagoon liners. Also, the site layout avoided significant archaeological areas on the property. The system includes ten miles of collection system and two pump stations. The first lagoon holds up to three million gallons (11,400 cubic meters), while lagoons 2 and 3 each handle up to 1.5 million gallons (5,700 cubic meters). Two operators share the responsibility for this plant, which provides service for approximately 2,000 residents.

While there are currently no plant upgrades foreseen, the Sewer District Trustees continue to discuss the potential upgrading of several areas of the collection system while working with the Town of Veazie to coordinate paving and road construction projects.

Firms interested in being considered to perform future design, contract administration and inspection services work over the next three years should submit **6 copies** of a Letter of Interest with an attached Statement of Qualifications. This Statement of Qualifications should include at a minimum:

- 1) A brief description of the business entity, or a company brochure;
- 2) The firm's qualifications to undertake wastewater plant and collection system projects;
- 3) The firm's experience with project budget and cost control;
- 4) A listing of similar wastewater plant and collection system projects that demonstrate the firm's capabilities;
- 5) A listing of recently completed work on similar type projects including the name, address and the telephone number of the client, or project contact, for each project;
- 6) Profiles of key personnel who will be involved in the Veazie projects;
- 7) A statement of workload over the next three years;
- 8) A listing of business references other than those listed above, including names of contacts and telephone numbers; and
- 9) Additional information, not to exceed one page, that would be useful in evaluating the firm's qualifications.

If a firm intends to undertake the project jointly with another firm, or use other consultants, the listing of qualifications and profiles of key personnel and their assigned roles must be included in the information provided to the District on the other firms to be used.

Responding firms' qualifications will be screened and ranked by the Trustees of the Veazie Sewer District. Qualified firms will be selected for an interview.

Firms selected for interviews will be asked to provide a schedule of rates for the staff that maybe involved in future Veazie Sewer District projects. The final schedule of rates will be negotiated with the firm determined to be best qualified for future projects.
