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A Note to Contractors, Plumbers and Applicants:

Re: Sewer Connection:

Some laterals in Veazie are (6") six-inch SDR 35 and are brought to the property line. Therefore a 6" to 4" reducer will be needed if 4" pipe is used from the property line to the building. Schedule 40 PVC, or SDR 35 pipe is required. Where any glued fitting is used, a PVC cleaner must be applied first, then glue.

It is a preferred method to use 4-inch SDR 35 PVC pipe from the residence to the main. Please note that the applicant must establish that enough slope is available from the building to the main when using 4-inch PVC pipe. A 6-inch stub may or may not be required and is at the discretion of the Superintendent on a case by case basis.

Per section 406 and 505 of the Veazie Sewer Districts Rules and Regulations, all testing of the building sewer shall be done at no cost to the District in the presents of the Superintendent and using such method as he shall stipulate if applicable.

As stated in the application, an inspection is required before any work is covered, with a 48-hour notice prior to digging. Dig Safe laws require a 72-hour notice to Sewer Districts. Friday are not a good day to start digging for a sewer connection to be inspected later in the day. Inspections will not be made after 3:00 p.m.

The SEWER CONNECTION CHARGE/APPLICATION should be present upon inspection for signature.

Plant personnel work Monday thru Friday 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
